

Mobius Joystick Troubleshooting

Introduction

When checked into Mobius and with tele-op on, if the joystick is not sending commands to the vehicle (e.g. dead-man doesn't release the vehicle's brake) the recommended troubleshooting method is to remap the controller. The following procedure details the steps necessary to remap a Logitech controller with Logitech and Mobius software.

Procedure

Logitech

1. Navigate Start > All Programs > Logitech > Logitech Gaming Software. This will open the Logitech Profiler window with a picture of the Logitech game-pad and a button layout.
2. To ensure the game-pad is communicating correctly with the CPU, press each of the buttons used during tele-operation and visually verify the appropriate response from the profile. For example, when pushing the dead-man button down the profile should show button 4 is being pressed.

3. Click on the Options button in the lower right hand corner of Mobius then click the Configure Joystick button. This will open the "Map Joysticks" window.
